As I worked my way through, I saw notes, letters, and old mission giving records that brought back memories, some sweet, some funny, some sad. I was reminded of generous, praying co-laborers who made the work in Haiti possible, and I was blessed to know that we will all meet again before our Father’s throne.

**Praise** I am very grateful for safety on the roads while driving to visit people and church families.

God has supplied all my needs, including places to stay during extended trips. Those visits have provided opportunities for extra meals with church family members and time to get to know people in a way that was not possible on a tight schedule in the past.

**Prayer** The rest of the churches that I hope to visit are in North and South Carolina. Please pray that I will be able to schedule all those meetings for this fall.

Please pray for Brandon and Regina Bell and their children as they move to the Santiago area of Dominican Republic after their recent furlough. We had some time together this spring, and the door is still open for possible short-term ministry opportunities.

Haiti now has some leadership, and Kenyan police forces have started to arrive. One concern is that the gangs will move their focus to areas outside of Port-au-Prince and the Artibonite valley. Please pray for wisdom for the new leadership and relief for the suffering Haitians.

*“Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God...”* (Ephesians 2:19) I have been blessed by so many believers in the United States and Haiti, some still here and some gone ahead to Heaven.
